
What is Upstream?

- A collaborative project to improve the availability, accessibility, and awareness of resources and services for youth and their families. The focus is on each community's resources and plans of action.
- The Missouri Behavioral Health Council is spear-heading Upstream Youth Mapping. They partner with the Missouri Department of Mental Health (DMH), the Office of State Courts Administrator (OSCA), Children's Division (CD), The National Center for State Courts (NCSC), and the Missouri Juvenile Justice Association (MJJA) to conduct Youth Mapping in Missouri.



Upstream Mapping

- **Focused on adult systems.**
- **Maps the criminal justice system**
- **Goal is to divert individuals from the criminal justice system.**

- **Focused on families and youth.**
- **Maps the juvenile justice and child welfare systems**
- **Goal is to strengthen communities, prevent child maltreatment and out-of-home placement, reduce court involvement, and support safe and healthy families.**

Both SIM and Upstream

- **Identify resources and gaps in services.**
- **Enhance relationships across systems and agencies.**
- **Create local action plans.**
- **Community-wide lens.**




Circuit 17 - Cass

They also intend to provide peer support for parents to work on the underlying issues that may contribute to truancy. They also plan






Upstream Follow
